# INTRODUCTION

# KNOWLEDGE



Linear elements, such as roads, waterways, and fences placed diagonally, are generally perceived as more dynamic than horizontally placed.

Put the focus point of your subject more to the right side rather than the left. Our eyes are used to reading text left to right, just like you are reading an article, so follow the same idea in your photos. This technique draws your viewer's eye in to the photo.

Lets take one photo with the leading lines from right going towards an interesting structure.

Now we are going to use some computer magic to flip it over.

# LEFT TO RIGHT



See any difference?

In the first photo you look at the subject and then quit looking. But in the one with the lines going right, you automatically look across the entire photo. Same photo, different result.

Obviously you wouldn't want to apply this rule blindly, but in some situations I have found it to make the composition just slightly more interesting.

# CHANGE POSITION

Sometimes it would be more beneficial to your photograph to move your point of view instead. In this case it would have looked better to move to the right across the bridge.

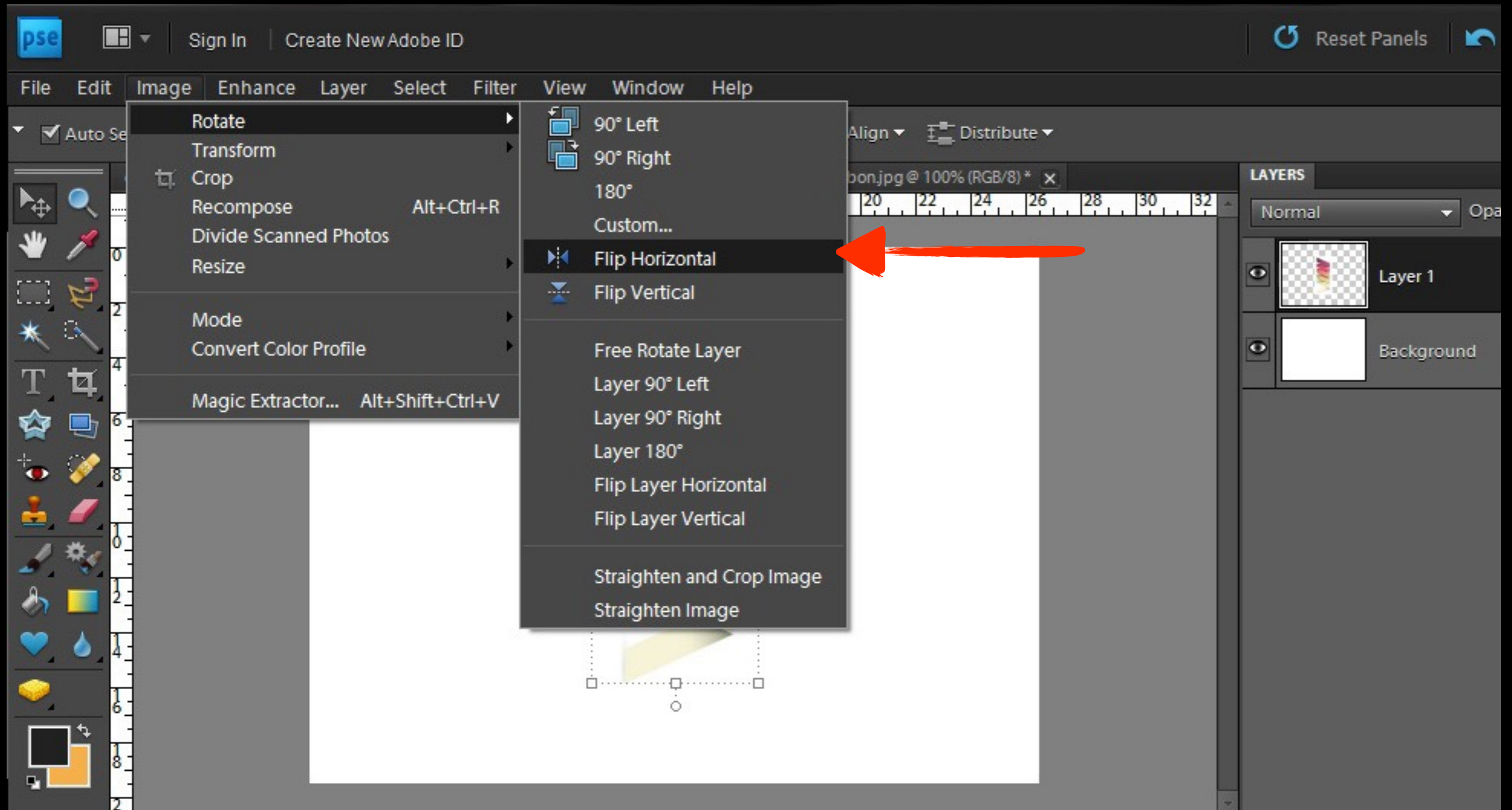

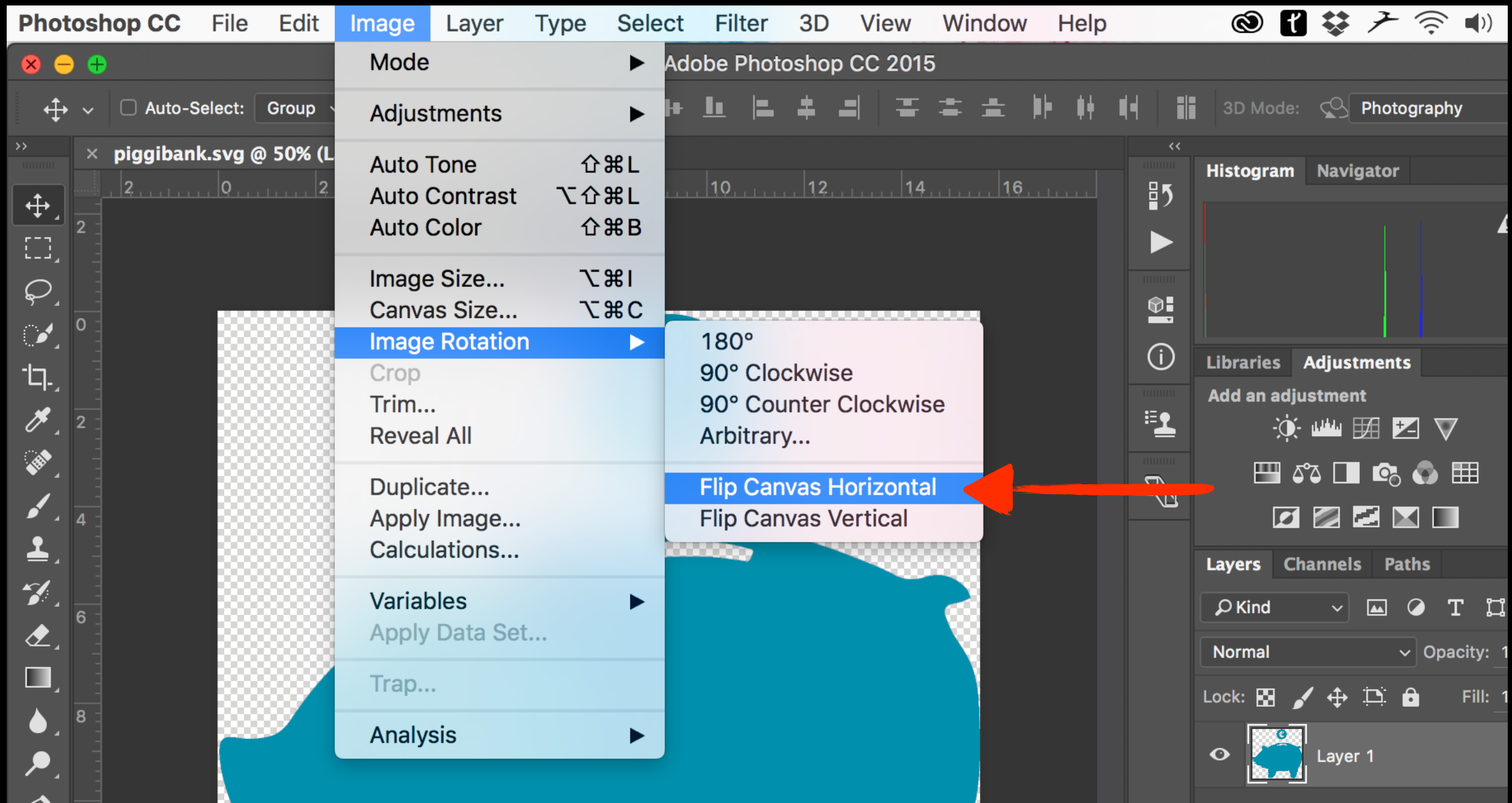

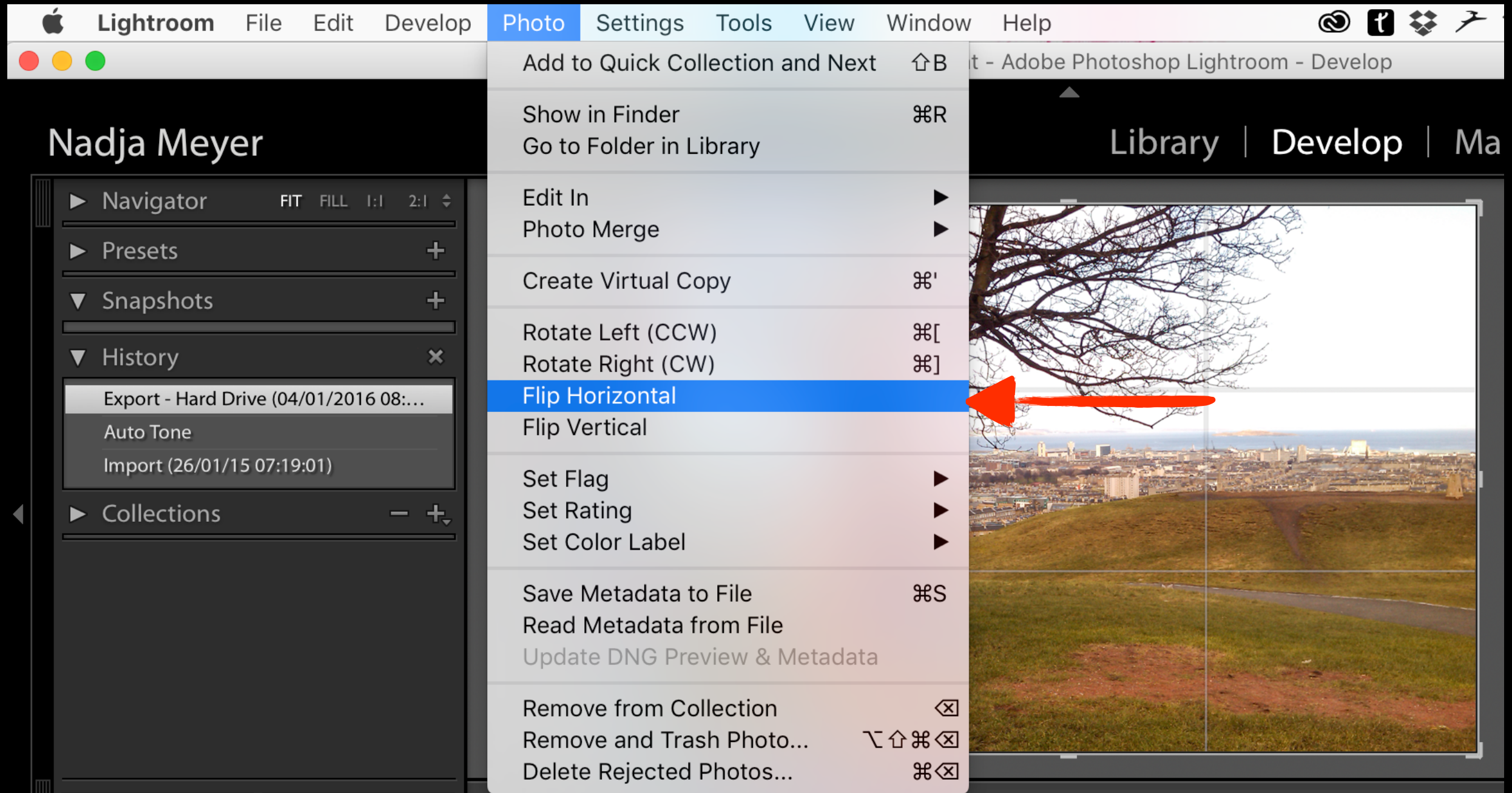
